Meeting Jesus in the Sacrament of Eucharist

- Mass in Chapel Monday to Thursday & Saturday at 8am (check out daily Mass schedules at a Church near your home or work or at the Miraculous Medal Shrine on Cheltenham Avenue)
- Mass in Church Saturday at 5pm & Sunday at 10am
- Eucharistic Adoration in Chapel on Thursday from 9am to 4pm (come and sit with Jesus; you will be amazed at this grace filled time of prayer). There is also Eucharistic Adoration all day on Tuesdays at St. Athanasius Church.

Meeting Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation

- Confessions on Saturday from 4:30 to 4:50pm; Sunday from 9:30 to 9:50am
- Confessions at St. Raymond Church on Sunday, March 29th from 2pm to 4pm
- Confession on Mondays (throughout the day) at the Miraculous Medal Shrine on Cheltenham Avenue
- Confession any time by appointment (just give Fr. Chris a call...really!)

Meeting Jesus in Faith Formation & Prayer

- Catholic Call to Prayer happens Monday to Friday at 6:30am and 12:10pm when a priest or deacon of one of the local parishes leads you (live) in prayer. Call 1-857-232-0158 and enter Code 336656. Allow this daily 5 minute encounter with the Lord to be a blessing this Lent!
- Join us for DISCIPLESHIP each Wednesday in the Rectory: from 6:30pm to 7:20pm there is a Women's Group, Men's Group and Prayer Group; from 7:30pm to 8:30pm there is Bible Study (as we slowly move through the Gospel of St. Mark).
- Join us on Tuesdays at 1:30pm in the Rectory Basement for Bible Study as we prepare for the upcoming weekend Mass Readings from Sacred Scripture.
- Have you been reading *The Real Story* that was given out at Christmas? Why not pick it up for Lent? There are other books available to borrow in the back of Church as well!

Meeting Jesus in the Stations of the Cross

- Join our School community each week on Wednesday at 1:30pm to Pray the Station of the Cross, the traditional Catholic Devotion that allows us to "walk with Jesus" in his agony to the Cross at Calvary. Please enter the Church through the "ramp doors" and meet us in Church.

Meeting Jesus in your own Unique Ways

- Use the internet as a prayer resource this Lent (go to www.saintraymond.net for links to great sites; the listing is under "Lenten Resources" which is under the "Christian Formation" banner)
- Find a book or devotional (check out our Parish Library in the back of Church) that will assist you in prayer and reflection.
